

CUT 2 – 2 ½" X 12" FELT STRIPS CUT 1 FABRIC – 6" WIDE X 10 ½" LONG CUT 3" PIECE OF VELCRO

1. SEW THE 2 ½" FELT STRIPS ¼" CREATING ONE PIECE ABOUT 23" LONG BY 2 ½" WIDE. FINGER PRESS OPEN.
2. FOLD 23" LONG STRIP WRONG SIDES TOGETHER (SEAM ON INSIDE) AND STITCH RAW EDGE ¼".
CUT FROM FOLD EDGE ABOUT ½" SPACING SECTIONS THE WHOLE 23" STRIP - LOOKS LIKE WIDE FRINGE.
DO NOT CUTTING THRU STITCH LINE*
3. STARTING AT ONE END WITH YOUR LARGE NEEDLE AND THREAD YOU WILL ROLL AND STITCH THE BOTTOM EDGE LIKE YOU ARE MAKING A FLOWER. YOU WILL BE ABLE TO HIDE YOUR STITCHES. SET ASIDE.
4. PRESS THE 6" X 10 ½" FABRIC IN HALF WRONG SIDES TOGETHER. OPEN AND PRESS THE TWO SIDES TOWARD THE MIDDLE PRESS LINE...YOU WILL HAVE A 2 ½" WIDE STRIP BY 10 ½" STRIP. PRESS GOOD.
5. OPEN THE STRIP UP FOLDING RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER AND SEW AT EACH END OF THE 10 ½" STRIP ¼". TRIM CORNERS AND TURN RIGHT SIDE OUT MAKING SURE YOUR CORNER POINTS ARE OUT. FOLD BACK TO THE 2 ½" WIDE STRIP. TOP STITCH AROUND WHOLE STRIP...I DO 2 ROWS.
6. STITCH ON VELCRO ON OPPOSITE ENDS OF STRIP - THIS IS YOUR CLOSURE. ADJUST TO YOUR WRIST SIZE.
7. FIND CENTER OF WRIST BAND AND HAND STITCH YOUR FELTED FLOWER ON. YOU CAN HIDE YOUR STITCHES.
